Activity Guidelines:

3. **Submission:** Upload the photograph on the official link: <https://ecoclubs.education.gov.in>
4. **Deadline:** Kindly ensure submission before *August 25, 2025*.
5. Take good care of the sapling, water it regularly, and ensure its healthy growth.
6. Maintain a **record of the plant’s growth** by clicking photographs from time to time and pasting them in a **scrapbook** along with short observations (height, number of leaves, flowers, etc.).
7. The **scrapbook should be submitted to the Science Teacher at the end of the academic year** as part of the student’s **value-based learning activity**.

Parents, together let us motivate our children to actively participate in this meaningful activity. With every sapling planted, we take a step closer to a healthier, greener planet and inspire our children to grow into responsible citizens.
